2010 AHA Guidelines: The ABCs of CPR Rearranged to "CAB"

The 2010 AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC make many of the same recommendations regarding rescue breathing as in 2005: Deliver each rescue breath over 1 second (Class IIa, LOE C). Give a sufficient tidal volume to produce visible chest rise (Class IIa, LOE C). 55. Use a compression to ventilation ratio of 30 chest compressions to 2 ventilations.

Hold the victim's airway open with head tilt-chin lift, pinch nose closed with your thumb and index finger, take a regular breath and seal your lips around the victim's mouth creating a tight airtight seal and give 1 breath. Watch to make sure the chest rise as you give the breath.
