The system classifies quality of evidence (as reflected in confidence in estimates of effects) as high (Grade A), moderate (Grade B), or low (Grade C) according to factors that include the risk of bias, precision of estimates, the consistency of the results, and the directness of the evidence.

The GRADE System for Rating Clinical Guidelines

Guideline panels will express GRADE's two directions of the recommendation either for or against an intervention or diagnostic test or strategy and the strength of this recommendation by either determining that it is a strong or a conditional recommendation.

Guideline development using GRADE

The Ministry of Health of Chile, aiming to improve the quality of clinical practice guidelines, gradually incorporated the GRADE system (Grading of Recommendations, Assessment, Development and Evaluation) to develop evidence based recommendations. This system summarizes and evaluates the certainty of the available evidence.
