The sixth edition provides explicit rules for direct quotations and states that you must credit the source when “ paraphrasing, quoting an author directly, or describing an idea that influenced your work ” (p. 170). If the quotation is less than 40 words, incorporate the quotation into the text and place quotation marks round the quotation.

To cite a textbook in a reference entry in APA style 6th edition include the following elements: Author (s) of the textbook: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to seven authors with the last name preceded by an ampersand (&). For eight or more authors include the first six names followed by an ellipsis (...) and add the last author's name.

Understanding this element of an APA Style reference can give you great flexibility when creating references. As indicated on page 186, “ nonroutine ” information can be included in brackets.
